WHO WE ARE?

Heavendoo Foundation is a forward-thinking environmental organization dedicated to creating sustainable, green ecosystems. We believe that real environmental change requires more than just good intentions; it requires long-term commitment, active nurturing, and community involvement.

Our Mission

Our goal is to combat the rapid loss of urban green spaces by implementing high-survival tree-planting initiatives. We step in where traditional "plant and abandon" drives fail, ensuring that every sapling we put in the ground is given the resources it needs to mature into a strong, life-giving tree.

WHAT IS PROJECT 480?

Project 480 is our flagship environmental restoration initiative. The mission is precise and deeply impactful: we are planting exactly 480 native saplings and committing to a rigorous, uninterrupted 5-year maintenance program.

Why 5 years? Because the first few years of a tree's life are its most vulnerable. By guaranteeing long-term care—including watering, pruning, and disease prevention—we ensure a near-perfect survival rate. Project 480 is not just about planting trees; it is about raising a self-sustaining micro-forest that will serve the community for generations to come.

WHY WE NEED PROJECT 480?

1.

The Urban Heat Island Effect

Concrete and asphalt trap heat, making urban areas significantly hotter than surrounding rural zones. Trees are nature's air conditioners.

2.

Declining Air Quality

Rapid development brings increased emissions and dust. We are losing the natural filters required to keep our air breathable.

3.

The "Plant and Forget" Epidemic

Countless saplings die within their first year due to a lack of aftercare. We need a model that prioritizes survival over sheer numbers.

EFFECT OF PROJECT 480?

1.

Air Quality & Oxygen

By the end of our 5-year maintenance phase, these 480 trees will absorb approximately 10,560 kg of CO₂ annually while producing enough clean oxygen to support over 2,100 people

2.

Urban Cooling & Shade

The maturing canopy will generate nearly 9,600 square meters of shade, effectively reducing local urban heat island temperatures by up to 3–5°C.

3.

Water Conservation

The thriving root systems will capture and filter up to 192,000 liters of rainfall per year, actively reducing runoff and replenishing depleted underground aquifers.

Implementation Phase

Phase 1

Planning & Survey

- Selection of resilient, native tree species.
- Stakeholder and community coordination.

Phase 2

Groundwork & Initial Deployment

- Clearing and preparing the planting site.
- Procuring high-quality saplings and organic fertilizers.

Phase 3

5-Year Maintenance (The Core)

- Regular watering schedules adapted to seasonal changes.
- Ongoing pest and disease monitoring to protect young trees.

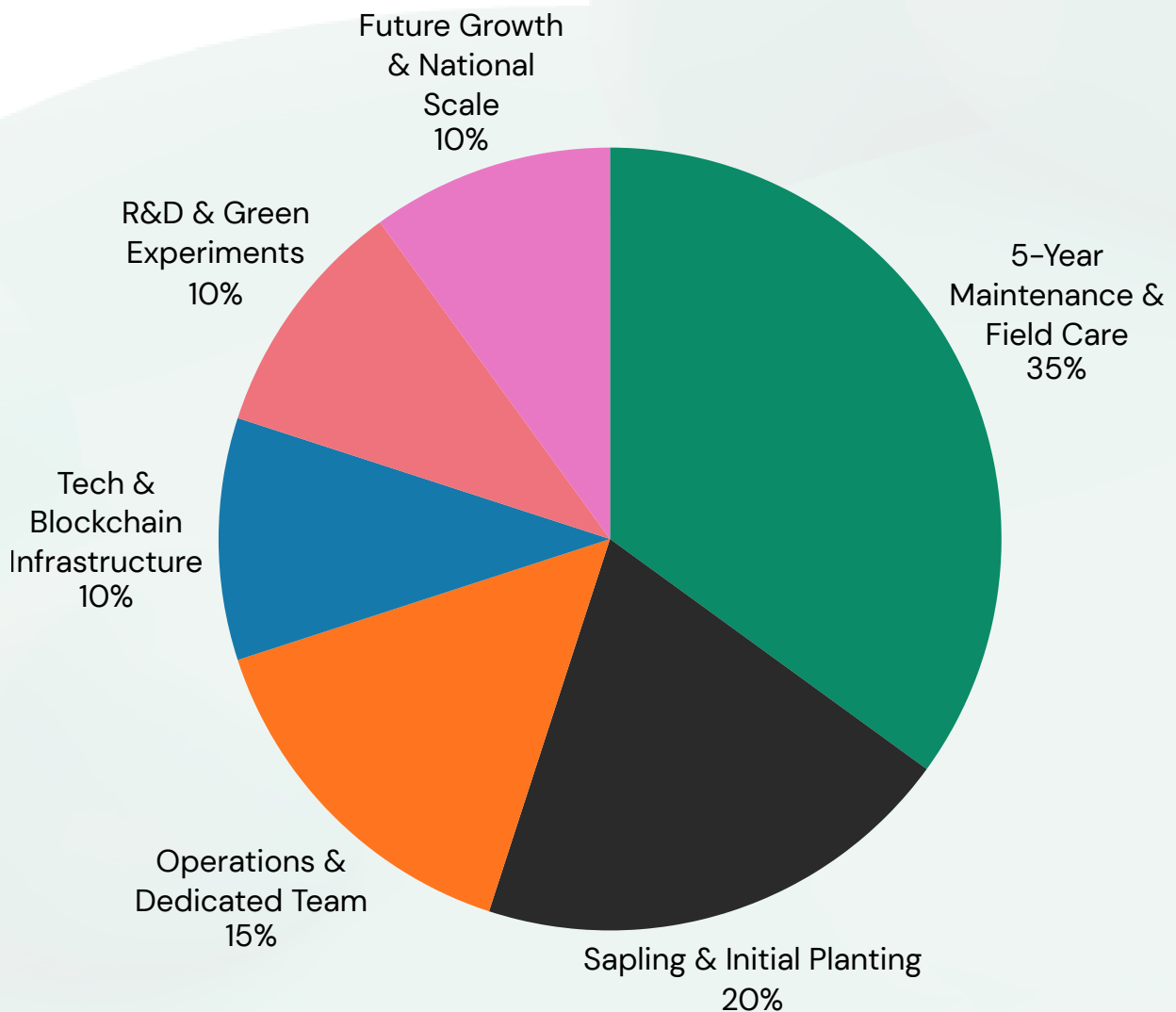
Phase 4

The Visionary 1 Rupee Donation Breakdown

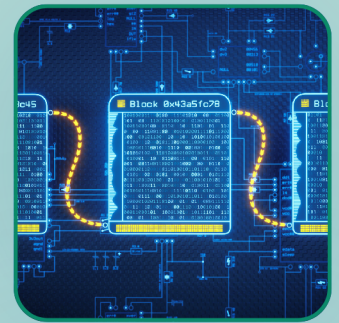

every planted tree is geo-mapped, allowing us to track the exact location and survival rate of our 480 trees.



Drone Canopy Surveys

We utilize periodic drone imaging to monitor the overall growth, health, and expansion of the micro-forest canopy over our 5-year commitment.
